

Many people argue that Christians shouldn't need a special day to celebrate Christ, since we recognize Jesus every Sunday and should be reminded of God's love every day. Some even claim that Christmas is actually rooted in pagan traditions, adapted to increase Christian followers. They point out that symbols like the tree, lights, and celebrations have origins in pre-Christian customs, introduced during the Roman Empire's conversion to Christianity under Emperor Constantine. Furthermore, they note that there is no record of Jesus' disciples celebrating His birth. In fact, the only celebration Jesus directly commanded was communion. So why do Christians celebrate Christmas?

When Jesus was crucified, He fulfilled the Old Testament Law, which included the practice of observing specific holy days like Passover. God had instructed the Israelites not to adopt pagan practices of worship when they entered the promised land, and when they ignored these commands, it led to their exile. Even in exile, the Jewish people held to the promise of a coming Messiah who would rescue them. They continued celebrating the Passover, commemorating their deliverance from Egypt and maintaining hope that God would one day send a Redeemer.

When Jesus came, He fulfilled this promise and changed everything. Since early Christians weren't allowed to worship in Jewish synagogues, they began gathering in their homes, away from Jewish influence. Christianity began to develop a more Gentile character. Jesus didn't leave a detailed set of instructions on worship; He simply commanded His followers to "go into all the world, teach, and baptize." We see Paul putting this into practice in Athens, where he connected with people by referencing their altar to an "unknown god" (Acts 17:22-25). Paul used elements of their culture to introduce them to Christ. Early Christians, though they were often forced to worship underground, obeyed this command with great sacrifice.

When Constantine legalized Christianity and made it the state religion, it grew rapidly across the Roman Empire and beyond. Pagan cults, which had once been dominant, became outlawed, and the church found ways to repurpose some familiar symbols and practices to point to Jesus. The early church didn't adopt these symbols for their original meanings but transformed them to reflect Christ's light. This is why we celebrate Christmas today—not because we borrowed pagan customs but because we redeemed them, using them as reminders of Jesus' birth and mission.

Today, when people see Christmas trees, lights, and other symbols, they're reminded of Jesus. Christmas is the start of the Christian celebration, which culminates at Easter. It's a time of hope and light, celebrating Christ's first coming and anticipating His return. Even though we don't know the exact date of Jesus' birth, many people associate December 25 with that event, seeing it as a time to remember the greatest gift we've received. While Christians don't need a special day to worship, the world needs a reminder of who Jesus is and the hope He brings. That is why we celebrate Christmas.




